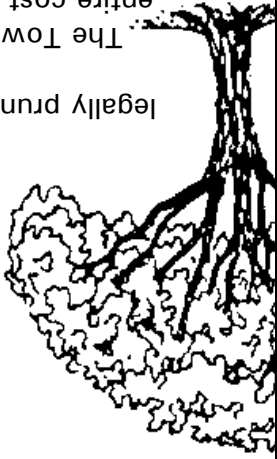


FREE ELM TREE PRUNING



Elm trees can be legally pruned (August 30 - April 1).

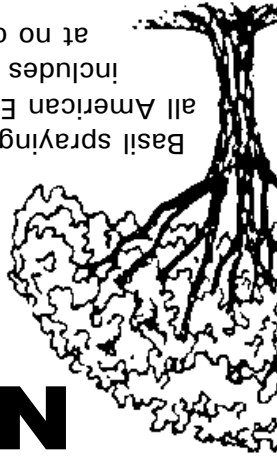
The Town of Greffell will pay the entire cost of pruning American Elm on both public and private property. This is possible with the assistance of a Dutch Elm Disease Control Program grant.

This pruning will be done on a priority basis. If you have an American Elm on your property with dead or damaged branches, please notify the town if you would like them pruned. Please do this as soon as possible.

NOTE: It is expected that the tree pruner will be in Greffell in October/November. The tree pruner will prune other varieties of trees as well and this cost will be the homeowner's.

NOTICE ELM TREE OWNERS



Basil spraying will soon commence on all American Elm trees in Greffell. This includes elms on private property at no cost to the homeowners.

The chemical being used is chlorpyrifos. It has a two year residual effect.

Any residents who object to having their elm trees sprayed should leave their written objections at the Town Office immediately.
